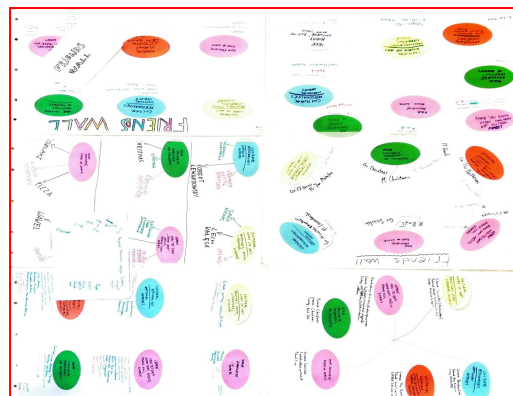
THURSDAY
